

Out of the Rough

The Holiday season is upon us! Colorful decorations adorn our homes and the Club, while the golf course has turned many shades of dormant brown. I am very thankful for the change in scenery as it's been an historic year in many ways.

I won't bore you with data overload but here are a few facts from the not-so-distant past. October brought .28" of rain. November to date we've received .2" of rain. This is staggering and when added to the rest of the year, gets us to nearly a 30" rain deficit here at the Club. That is about half of our average rainfall for the year. Can you imagine what your business or personal finance situation might look like if incomes were cut in half? It might sound like a silly analogy but trust me, the turf and golf course feel the same way!

Here is the latest map from the National Drought Monitor. I anticipate a change in this by January as well above average rainfall may be coming our way. For now we remain in the worst classification they have, Exceptional Drought.



Recently we installed some new irrigation between the 1st and 5th holes. This will help alleviate challenges with a poorly designed single row irrigation system on those holes. Given the amount of rock in the area, we were forced to use our antiquated backhoe for the project. We will let the trench settle over the next couple weeks before topping it off with topsoil and sod. The area is marked and played as "Ground Under Repair." We installed 4 new heads, 1 quick coupler for hand watering and 1 isolation valve. Due to the proximity to the satellite box, we were able to link the heads to the computer control system for automation. This was a wonderful project that took less than 2 days!







We will soon begin removing dead Leyland Cypress trees along Timberlinks. In its place will be a mound to screen the street and help keep golf balls on the course. The finished product will resemble these two photos. More information about the process can be found at https://richsoil.com/hugelkultur/
