

## Out of the Rough

Happy New Year from the Turf Team! The staff has reassembled after taking some well-deserved time off for the holidays. We would like to thank the membership for once again showing their generosity and contributing to the Employee Christmas Fund. We are very thankful and proud to serve each and every one of you! Here are a few facts about 2016 and a brief look at what lies just ahead in 2017.

Rainfall- 2016 brought 43.94" rain to the golf course. This is 18.97" below average for the year. We received above average rainfall in 3 months of the year and were below average in the other 9 months. We ended the year with above average rainfall in November and December. For the year we recorded just under 6" of snow. Currently our area remains in Extreme Drought, a testament to just how dry it was during the spring and summer months of 2016.



2016's drought forced us to irrigate the golf course much more than in years past and as a result we had to make several system repairs mid-season. The good news is the system operates better than it did going in to 2016. The bad news is that we all saw just how poor the system coverage really is.







Currently the staff is focused on 3 main objectives. The 1st is leaf collection, which can seem never-ending. The 2nd task is the mound project along Timberlinks. The 3rd is repairing the fence along the 14th. Heavy rainfall and flooding late in 2016 wreaked havoc on our split-rail fence at 14. When the course is too wet for traffic the staff has been strengthening the fence by setting the posts in concrete. This seems simple, but as you might imagine, this area has very shallow soil. Anchoring the posts means breaking through bed rock and asphalt which is obviously quite slow and laborious.

The temperature rate + tax includes the cart fee. Barring an unforseen seasonably warm day in January of February, temperature rates cannot exceed our regular Guest Rates.
