Out of the Rough

Course Report March 2018

Cold weather has backed off and although it has been very wet I'm excited to say we have been productive on a few projects that have been kicked around the past couple of years. I'll get to that but first I want to fill you in on our aerification schedule. We will aerify greens with 3/8" tines on a very tight spacing the week of March 5... Weather permitting. Some greens and areas of some greens will be double aerified. The recovery time will be less than usual. Our late fall aerification was very aggressive and so this spring the focus will be on using a smaller tine with a much tighter spacing pattern.

We have several projects to talk about so let's get right to them.

The old flower bed at the practice green has been removed. This area will be smoothed and then sodded with Bermudagrass and Zoysia grass. It will be maintained at approach height. This will provide considerably more area to chip from and will allow you to practice a variety of lies. The flag pole will be relocated at a later time.



The mounds right of the 7th green are being elevated. The goal of this project is to keep a few more golf balls in play.



The large oak tree near 3 tee has been removed. This tree shaded the 2nd green but perhaps most importantly was very detrimental to the health of the 3rd tee. The 3rd hole being a short par 3 that receives a tremendous amount of divots, couldn't overcome the shade and competition from the tree. The area will be sodded and the actual teeing space of the area enlarged slightly.



The approach bunker on the 8th hole is being covered in soil and will be sodded. The bunker was in very poor condition and was really only there to save some shots from rolling down the hill and going out of bounds. We believe a grassed surface depression will serve the same purpose.
