Out of the Rough

December is upon us and the closing of another year is just weeks away. The Club has been beautifully decorated thanks to our awesome ladies group lead by Donna Morrison and Suzanne Caplenor. I personally want to thank these two ladies for their service to the Club. I know they donated a great deal of their time to ensure the Club looks its best for our Membership this holiday season. The staff and I wish everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy Holiday.

Turning to the course, the turf team has been very productive this fall with leaf collection and tree work. Our goal each year is to have leaf collection concluded by Christmas... assuming Mother Nature provides the needed assistance. This year we are actually ahead of schedule and by mid-December, we will be moving on to several projects that address playability, plant heath and our aging infrastructure on the course. Here are a few things to look forward to this winter:

- -Building New Benches for the Course
- -Repairing / Replacing Several Irrigation Heads
- -Expanding the Chipping Area at Putting Green
- -Smoothing Several Drain/ Irrigation Lines in Fairways/ Roughs
- -Continued Removal of Exposed Rock in Fairways
- -Brush Removal on Perimeter of Holes 8, 12 &13

With cold weather here to stay for a few months, let me remind everyone of a few critical issues:

- -Frost delays always include the putting green.
- -You must check in with the golf shop prior to play. This helps ensure you are aware of the day's playing conditions and any special circumstances that may be pertinent to your round of golf.
- -Course restrooms will close for the season as freezing temperatures become more persistent. Signs will be posted in the golf shop as needed
- -Blankets will be used to protect the turf from winterkill as needed. This will mostly be on the back 9 and could result in closure of those holes in the event of an extended cold snap.
