Out of the Rough

The 2017 Tournament Schedule is behind us! Where has the time gone? The crew has been able to complete all aerification procedures and did so just in the nick of time. Several cold fronts have made their way through Signal Mountain and turf growth has slowed considerably. In fact it was snowing on the mountain October 29th. We have made, and will continue to make several fertilizer applications to the greens to keep them growing and healing as much as possible this fall. Obviously the down side to aerifying this late is the challenge of getting the greens healed up but there is 1 big positive... cool temperatures allow us to be very aggressive with our hole size and spacing as well as allowing us to apply a tremendous amount of sand to the greens. Cool temperatures also allow us to work that material into the holes with little stress to the turf. This greatly improves our firmness and drainage while slowing the accumulation of organic matter and compaction in our putting surfaces.




With aerification behind us, the focus now shifts to leaf collection and some necessary tree removals. Please be patient as leaf collection usually lasts until the New Year.


Golf News
