Out of the Rough

The arrival of March brings the end to several projects the team has taken on this winter. We now must shift our focus to prepping the course for play each day and aerifying our putting surfaces. This year's spring aerification will take place March 6th – March 10th. We will use 5/8" tines and pull plugs up to 6" deep from the surface. Greens set in wet / shaded microclimates will be double or triple aerified. As usual, holes will be filled with sand as the weather allows in the days following aerification. Expect 9 hole closures to help the staff facilitate these procedures.



In conjunction with Paul's efforts to upgrade accessories at the practice facility, we have made hitting line dividers. These new dividers, which look like oversized tee markers, will be used daily after March 1. Hitting from areas outside of these dividers will be a violation of range policy as we need a system that will allow us to maximize our limited space. The artificial turf is also available each day for those who would prefer to practice from the top tee.



The berm along the 9th is almost complete and seeding will take place sometime in early March as we want to coordinate that with Mother Nature. I appreciate the compliments we've received on that project and look forward to getting some turf established there this spring. This picture will give you an idea of what the finished product will resemble.
