
Golf News

Prepaid Guest Rounds can be purchased for \$50 each + tax. This is a \$20 savings on normal weekly rates and a \$30 savings on weekend rates.

- Prepaid Guest Rounds may be purchased through February 28th, 2021.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds may be used anytime during the 2021 calendar year.
- Any unused Guest Rounds will be forfeited after Dec 31st, 2021.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds are subject to the Club's Guest Policy.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds are non-transferrable.


