Thank you to everyone who participated in The Mountaineer this year, the tournament was a success and we received lots of great comments on the condition of the golf course. The Mountaineer is a milestone in our calendar. Play tends to slow down, our staff begins to shrink as school is starting back up and we pivot to a more defensive agronomic strategy. The next few weeks are usually the hottest and most humid of the year and we want to protect the greens so that we can go into aeration with a healthy stand of grass. To do this we raise mowing heights, decrease mowing frequency and have a less aggressive setup with our mowers. We do this to help the plant conserve as much energy as possible and protect our shrinking root profile. What this means for the golfer is we will have slower greens that we saw in May and June. Aeration is scheduled for later this month, hopefully we will have as lovely of a fall (but slightly wetter) as we did last year and we can get these greens back to their fighting weight soon. It is hard to believe that the next time you read this newsletter, it will be football season. Bring on the leaves!
