The Tournament Program has been released and hoping to get another large contingency of participants. The Tournament Program is one of the best deals in all of Chattanooga. For only \$300, you can prepay for 13 tournaments that would cost you \$545 if you paid for each individually. We also have a discounted Program Fee for the Ladies. The Ladies program fee is \$100. Please contact the golf shop if you would like to sign up. You will notice a change to our One Day Member-Member/Member-Guest events. We will still have 2 of the Member-Member-Member-Guest and will replace the other 2 with a Member and 3. The Member and 3 will be a 4-person team that can range from a member and 3 guests to a team with 4 members (any combination as long as there is at least one member on the team).

Stop in the golf shop for your 2024 Tournament Schedule magnet. We should have them available in a couple of weeks. These are a great reference to keep handy to see what is going on at the club. I would especially like to thank David O'Neal, Haven Burns, Dean Hogue and Craftique Manufacturing for once again providing the magnets.

There is still time to purchase your 2024 Prepaid Guest Rounds. From now through February 29th all golf members may once again pre-purchase up to 6 guest rounds for use during the 2024 calendar year. Prepaid Guest Rounds can be purchased for \$50 each + tax. This is a \$20 savings on normal weekly rates and a \$30 savings on weekend rates.

- Prepaid Guest Rounds may be purchased through February 29th, 2024.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds may be used anytime during the 2024 calendar year.
- Any unused Guest Rounds will be forfeited after Dec 31st, 2024.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds are subject to the Club's Guest Policy.
- Prepaid Guest Rounds are non-transferrable.

Now that we are closing in on the golf season, it is very important to check-in with the golf shop before going to play. This is imperative for many different reasons. Checking in helps the Club accurately keep track of our rounds throughout the year. More importantly, this lets us convey any course conditions and maintenance work happening on the course. This keeps the course in its best condition as well as keeping our maintenance staff safe. It also keeps our members safe in the event of inclement weather moving in. If the golf staff knows of golfers on the course, we can safely get them off before a storm hits.


Putts From The Fringe

A Special Message from the Board of Directors

We would like to remind everyone the Club's policy regarding charges and billings to your Club account. The below excerpt is directly from the Club Rules. This policy has historically been loosely enforced. Beginning March 1, this policy will be fully enforced with no exceptions. Please ensure your account is paid in a timely manner to avoid late charges and/or suspension of club privileges. Please note that if any portion of your account becomes 60 days past due, the member's privileges will be suspended until the total balance is paid in full.

We offer a variety of payment methods including credit card, automatic bank debit (no charge), or a check. Automatic bank debit forms can be requested from Katherine Powers (kpowers@smgcc. org) or Kelly Thompson kthompson@smgcc.org in our Business Office.

CHARGES AND BILLING

All charges for food and beverage are to be against the member's club account or credit card. Cash or credit cards will be accepted in the golf shop for carts, guest fees and merchandise sales. Service charges will be applied to payment methods that require the Club to pay a fee on the transaction. For example, credit card payments.

All charges are due and payable by the 10th of the month following the month charges are incurred. If any portion of a member's account is not paid by the start of the next billing period (i.e. the last day of the month) the account will be considered delinquent 30 days and a late penalty of 10% with a \$25.00 minimum will be charged on the unpaid balance.

If any portion of a member's account becomes 60 days delinquent, the member's privileges will be suspended until the total balance is paid in full. Any account that is 90 days delinquent may be turned over to collection.


