Putts From The Fringe


It is exciting to watch the golf course transition from winter to spring, despite the cool weather the warm season grasses are greening up nicely. The next 4-6 weeks of preparing the golf course will be critical for the upcoming schedule.

After six straight aerations with agreeable weather, we finally had some rain during the process. The rain slowed us down and we did not get a perfect final product, the good news is a few dry stretches have given the greens the opportunity to send vigorous roots diving deep in search of water. We are in a good position to start the spring and summer with fast, firm and healthy greens.

Hopefully you have had time to check out our recent driving range project. Our previous range mat system required glue to hold the mats in place. The new slab with recessed trays gives us a clean look that will also be more functional. These mats allow for a tee to be inserted, please give hitting a driver from the new mats a chance before teeing it up off of the grass. The expanded tee area will allow for us to set the range up on grass more often. We still have some buttoning up to do around the slab and it will take some time before the new sod is ready for divots.

I definitely feel better about the spring transition right now than I did this time last year. We have made some changes to try to protect the turf from winter damage but I blamed Mother Nature last year so I have to give her the credit this year. Thank you for your continued support!




