

We have received our first shipment of material for our irrigation renovation, I expect the contractor to be on site by the middle of the month with the first heads being put in the ground in early October. You may have already noticed some contractors working on the back 9 to make repairs to the town's sewage system. They will likely be in and out over the coming weeks and months. In my experience working with municipalities making sewage repairs, it is best to try to let them do their thing and they are typically very good about making the golf course whole and working around our golf schedule. The reality of having a golf course in a residential area is that sometimes we need to give access to the sewer people.

Very excited for the fall golf season with the tournaments we have and with the improvements to the golf course. Pray for some rain before the irrigation project, enough to keep us green but not so much that it slows us down.


SMGCC BOOK CLUB
