Putts From The Fringe

After a warm fall, it looks like winter is finally here to stay. I can't recall ever seeing the fairways this lush and green this late in the year. Considering how dry most of the growing season was, October turned out to be the greenest month on the golf course after the rain brought by Helene.

The big news on the golf course is the irrigation system installation. So far, I'm happy with both the contractor and the progress. The crew is primarily focused on installing the mainline pipe on the back nine before moving on to the lateral lines and heads. The disturbed areas are being put back together nicely, and most of the visible mess comes from moving materials and equipment in and out of the work areas.

As expected, we've encountered our fair share of rock. The crew has been able to break through it without significant delays. One reason we chose this contractor is their readiness to handle the rock without adding unexpected costs for breaking it apart. The only additional expense on our end is hauling the rock off site and providing backfill dirt. If we were working with a rock contingency, where costs were based on breaking rock by the foot or hour, this project would be much more stressful. This crew came prepared with a dedicated rock hammer and excavator. If we hadn't hit any rock, I don't believe we'd be much further along in the project.

I'll continue to provide updates about the project and hole closures on Clubster. You can adjust your preferences in the app to receive push notifications on your phone or email alerts.
