## Putts From The Fringe

After four weeks of bad weather and minimal progress, the irrigation project is moving full speed ahead. A second crew that had been working in Massachusetts is now on property and will be focusing on greens and tee irrigation. Because of this, we will likely be down two holes at a time for the next few weeks. We will have over 40 people on the ground getting this system in, with two rock hammers running consistently. It turns out there is a reason this place isn't called Signal Easy Diggin Golf and Country Club.

I am looking forward to a busy spring getting this golf course put back together. The next two years are going to be a blast as we figure out how to get the most out of this system and see its impact on the golf course and the golf maintenance operation.

Thank you for your continued patience with the closures, the mess, and the noise. Like most surgeries, this project has brought inconvenience and will require recovery, but the final product will be worth it.
